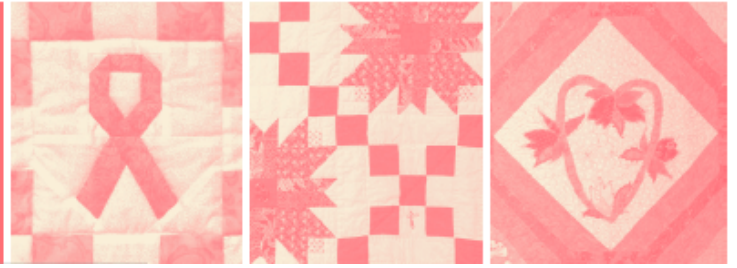


James Stitching Sisters

Donate a completed quilt (at least 48 x 60 inches, machine or hand-quilted) to "212 Quilts for 2012". This year we will continue the "Pick-a-Pair" option. With pick-a-pair you may pick a pieced quilt top and backing from those already completed at the sewing center; just add quilting and binding to enter into the quilt challenge. All supplies, including batting may be picked up at the sewing center.
